member, consider joining! You will find this group a very lively and friendly bunch with lots to offer other Villagers.



One hour/one mile (Introductory),
North Rueda Canyon - walk north from
Tierrasanta Blvd up-a-ways in the
canyon, & then back to the starting point:
On Fri, 14 Apr 2017 (second Friday) at 9
AM, we gather on Rueda Drive next to
Tierrasanta Blvd. (Drive east on
Tierrasanta Blvd, past the library & down
the hill to Rueda Drive, turn left & park.)
The route is relatively flat along the

The route is relatively flat along the canyon floor. The trail starts as a six foot wide utility gravel road but eventually narrows to a three foot wide trail. This season the vegetation is very diverse.

2 hour/2+ miles (Tierrasanta Canyons)
Northwest canyon Loop - this route
pieces together various park, open
space, & private walkways to give an
interesting view of this section of our
community. On Fri, Apr 28 2017 (fourth
Friday), we gather at 9 AM. (Meet at the
ATM at the north end of the Vons
shopping center, next to Santo Road.)
There is some up & down. Long pants &
a walking stick are recommended (- some
spare sticks are available to use). This
time of year is a great time to be
outdoors.

Bev opened our Event with a few classic stories and a prayer. Jocelyn, Gloria and Marilyn did a great job organizing the food and trivia quiz.




