Village Hiking

2 hour/2+ mile (Tierrasanta Canyons), Shepherd Canyon Loop (counter clockwise - community pond to Vallarta Drive). On **Fri, 06 Apr 2018 (first Friday)**, we gather at 9 AM. (Go on Santo Road past the Von's shopping center, turn right on Antiqua Road. At the next right turn, go east on Playa Veracruz to just-past the Playa Encino intersection to where there's a gate on the right. Stop/park.) The route has mostly 6 foot wide utility roads, plus some 3 foot wide paths. You're mostly In canyons (East Shepherd, then by connecting trails over to North Shepherd); there should be water down in the stream beds making the area lush.

1.5 hour/1.5+ mile (Mission Trails), Tierrasanta Mini-peak (on west slope of Fortuna Mountain ridgeline, below the saddle), & back. On **Fri, 20 Apr 2018 (third Friday)**, we gather at 9 AM at the east end of Clairemont Mesa Blvd. We'll be going off the mesa down into Suycott Wash, first time. We may not climb the mini-peak, just get close to it. You should bring hiking sticks, or I can loan you on. The route has mostly 6 foot wide utility roads, plus some 3 foot wide paths. This is chaparral country, with beautiful views.
