Roy's Guacamole

Ingredients: Avocados Salsa Verde, La Victoria Thick 'N Chunky,

Medium (not hot or mild)

Garlic Powder Pepper Salt

Instructions:

Cut avocado flesh into small pieces into a medium bowl.

Add Salsa Verde. I also use the Salsa Verde to give me the right consistency

Add Garlic Powder - a good amount. Add salt and pepper.

Stir and crush. If making for 2-4 people, I do this with a fork in a small bowl. If making a large amount, I use a mixer in a larger bowl. I like the

guacamole thoroughly crushed but still with small chunks of avocado.

Taste and adjust as necessary. Usually it needs more salt.

"Life of Pi" - Drama / Action - 2012

Ang Lee, Director - 3-Oscar Winner

"Pi" is a nick-name for a 16 year old young man named Piscene Patel who lives in Pondicherry, India with his parents & brother. The family owns a zoo in a lovely large park in the city. For various political reasons, Pi's father decides to move the family & zoo to another new location in Canada. After deciding to sell their zoo in India & move to Canada, the Patel family boards a freighter with their belongings and a smaller group of animals. Tragedy strikes when a terrible storm in the Pacific Ocean sinks their ship, leaving "Pi" as the only human survivor. A good swimmer since early childhood, Pi manages to swim to the surface & find a lifeboat. However, Pi is not alone; a fearsome Bengal tiger has also found refuge aboard the lifeboat! As days turn into weeks. & weeks drag into months. Pi & the tiger must learn to trust each other if both are to

"Pi" is based on a novel published in 2001 by Yann Martel, & has sold more than 10 million copies, earning over US \$609 million worldwide. The film received 11 Oscar Nominations and won four: Best Director (Ang Lee), Best Original Music Score, Best Cinematography, & Best Visual Effects.

Friday -- April 26 - 12:30 - 2:30 PM "THE STING" - Drama / Comedy - 1973 Paul Newman, Robert Redford Robert Shaw, Charles Durning

"The Sting" is a 1973 American <u>caper</u> film set in Chicago in September 1936 at the height of the <u>Great Depression</u>. It involves a complicated plot by 2 professional grifters (Newman & Redford) to con a mob boss (Shaw), who has killed one of their buddies. The "Sting" was inspired by real-life cons (the brothers Fred & Charley Gondorff) & was documented by David Maurer in his book <u>The Big Con: The Story of the Confidence Man</u>. The title phrase refers to the moment when a con artist finishes the "play" & takes the "mark's" money. If a con is successful, the "mark" does not realize he has been cheated until the con men are long gone.

The film is noted for it's anachronistic use of ragtime, particularly the melody "The Entertainer" by Scott Joplin, which was adapted (along with others by Joplin) for the movie by Marvin Hamlisch (& a top-ten chart single for Hamlisch when released as a single from the film's soundtrack". The film's success created a resurgence of interest in Joplin's work.

The film received rave reviews and was a box office smash in 1973-74, taking in more than US \$160 million (\$800 million today). As of August 2018 it is the 20th highest-grossing film in the US adjusted for ticket price inflation. The Sting was nominated for 10 Oscars & won 7: Best Picture, Director, Original Screenplay, Art Direction, Costume Design, Film Editing, & Original Score.

In 2005, <u>The Sting</u> was preserved in the U.S. National Film Registry of the Library of Congress as being "culturally, historically, or aesthetically significant".


Four Village day hike participants started & finished the climb to North Fortuna Peak (1,291 feet) in mid-March. An ice cream social will take place at the "Saddle" (about 1,000 feet) - between North & South peaks this month to celebrate the accomplishment. Everyone is invited, but of course those flat landers whose climbing skills have been allowed to deteriorate over the years, might have a little physical exercising to do before starting up. One last note: I used to lead a lot of kid-trips and have had children as young as 8 years old make it up to the Saddle - of course ice cream was involved in some of those cases too.

Two hour/two+ mile (Tierrasanta Canyons), Tambor Connector-North Rueda Canyon (rim) Loop: On Fri, 05 Apr 2019 (first Friday), we gather at 8:30 AM. (Drive east on Tierrasanta Blvd past the library, down the hill to the last left turn, Colina Dorada Drive. Turn and go to Pendiente Court, turn left & go to the end of the cul de sac. Stop/park.) This route is a potential short cut from Tierrasanta Blvd up to Rueda Drive area. The North Rueda rim portion of this loop is another opportunity to experience the "(palm) stump-tour", viewing downward.

Two hour+/two+ mile (Mission Trails), CM Blvd entrance to Mount Fortuna Saddle (& back); there will also be an ice cream social up on the Saddle. On Fri, 19 Apr 2019 (third Friday), we gather at 8:30 AM at the east end of CM Blvd; park on the street. Bringing a hiking stick (for safety) is recommendation. With agreement, we may also be able to climb to South Fortuna, and take the stairs down to get back to the start.

Two+ hour/two+ mile (Mission Trails), CM Blvd entrance to San Diego River crossing & the Visitor Center (& back): On Fri, 03 May 2019 (first Friday), we gather at 8:30 AM at the east end of CM Blvd; park on the street. This day hike gives you the chance to touch the water in a running river and spent up to one half a hour searching the recesses of the center building.
