Hiking With Bob

Two-hour/two-mile (Mission Trails), Quarry Loop: On Fri, 02 Aug 2019 (first Friday), we gather at 8:30 AM at the intersection of Calle de Vida & Colina Dorado. (Drive east on Clairemont Mesa Blvd to Rueda Drive (last right turn); go south on Rueda two blocks to Calle de Vida; turn left & go east to the sharp right hand turn to Colina Dorada; stop & park on the street.) This is a relatively short distance with a 100' climb - a summer trip. The views are outstanding.

Two-hour/two-mile (Tierrasanta Canyons), South Rueda - southern loop: On Fri, 16 Aug 2019 (third Friday), we gather at the south (dead) end of La Cuenta. (Drive east on Tierrasanta Blvd to La Cuenta; turn right past the library, fire station, Farb Middle School a long way, to the end; stop & park.) There's descent into the canyon, and of course the climb back up. A hiking stick is recommended. We may climb clubhouse peak to look over the Navv golf course, and other interesting stuff. In general, utility roads are at least 6' wide, and trails are at least 3' wide. Vegetation in Mission Trails is mostly chaparral - plus some cactus & (canyon bottom) oaks. Tierrasanta Canyons (down bottom) receive more water from canyon-side runoff, and are more lush.
