Someone You Should Know

Mike Rigdon was born in Lancaster, Wisconsin in 1941. His family moved to Fort Worth, Texas in 1951. He attended Laneri High School and University of Texas, Arlington.

Mike enlisted in the Navy in October of 1961, with "boot camp" in San Diego. Then he served on the USS Jupiter AVS-8 from October 1962, until it's decommissioning in June of 1964. He also stood watch on the Battleship USS Missouri (site of the end of WW II) while it was "moth-balled" at Bremerton, Washington. His last tour of duty was with VU-3, a Utility Squadron at North Island NAS, San Diego, until July 1965.

He remained in San Diego rather than return to Texas. After finishing his BA and MA at San Diego State University, he taught Industrial Arts for thirty years in San Diego high schools. He retired from Kearny High in 1998.

Since attending the 1996 Reunion of the USS Jupiter, Mike has been Historian and Newsletter Editor for the ship for twenty-one years. He has hosted eight Jupiter Reunions across the country, three in San Diego. Some of his fondest memories have been meeting many true war heroes during those ship Reunions.

Being an avid photographer, Mike's specialty in retirement has been traveling. He has attended three or more ship Reunions yearly, all over the country, and has taken many overseas trips and cruises.

The most memorable was a cruise from Australia to Japan in 2006, visiting the Islands of Admiral Nimitz's Campaign in WW II. The last stop for that cruise was Yokosuka, Japan, where his ship, USS Jupiter AVS-8, was stationed for fourteen years. Mike has been a Volunteer Curator aboard the USS Midway CV-41 for fifteen years. The Aircraft Carrier Museum, now a major part of the San Diego waterfront, is a world famous "flat-top" destination.

Mike has volunteered as a Board member and Treasurer for Tierrasanta Village of San Diego. He is also the Editor and Photographer for this monthly 8-page Village VIBES newsletter. Volunteering has been a huge part of his life.

Mike's words to live by:

"Don't search for the meaning of life. Simply be present for the people you love."

"The Agony and the Ecstasy"

Historical Biography - 1965

Charlton Heston - Rex Harrison

Charlton Heston & Rex Harrison portray 2 of the Renaissance's most colorful figures in this historical drama, based on author Irving Stone's best-seller novel. When Pope Julius II (Harrison) commissions Michelangelo (Heston) to paint the ceiling of Rome's Sistine Chapel, he initially refuses, claiming he is really a sculptor, not a painter. But later he is commanded by the Pope to paint the ceiling anyway. He does so begrudgingly, then destroys his initial work and flees from Rome. He eventually returns to ask Julius to restore his commission.

While Irving Stone's novel covers Michelangelo's life from birth to death, the film focuses on the battle of wills between the perfectionist sculptor and the impatient Pope Julius II, who first commissions (and eventually commands) him to paint the famed Chapel.

The film received 5 Oscar Nominations: Best Cinematography, Art Direction, Costume Design, Original Music Score, and Sound. It also received 2 Golden Globe Nominations: Best Actor (Harrison) and Best Screenplay.

"We Bought a Zoo" Comedy / Family Drama - 2011

Matt Damon - Scarlett Johansson

Oscar Winner Matt Damon gives a heartfelt performance in this family film based on a true story. When Benjamin Mee (Damon) loses his wife, he suddenly becomes a single father to their 2 children. Wishing to move to a more family-oriented neighborhood (after his teenage son gets into some trouble) he hires a real estate agent to find a new home for them in a quiet country location. Finding the "perfect" home was easy except for 1 requirement -the home came with a small zoo - complete with animals and a small zookeeper staff.

Mee (Damon) gave up a lucrative newspaper job to move the family to this most unlikely place: a zoo, with help from an eclectic staff and many misadventures along the way. He embarked upon a fresh beginning to successfully restore the dilapidated zoo to its former glory, while uniting his family.

Hiking With Bob

Two hour/two+ mile (Tierrasanta Canyons), Shepherd Canyons Loop. On Fri, 03 Jan 2020 (first Friday), we gather at 8:30 AM at Villarrica Way. (From the US Post Office shopping center, drive east on Portobello Drive to the second intersection - Villarrica Way. Turn right & go 25 yards, or so. Stop/park.). This loop which briefly darts in & then out of Mission Trails is probably the first loop devised in Tierrasanta Canyons. Shepherd Canyons (north & east) are two of the most popular routes our community has. (We expect to go clockwise.)

Two+ hour/four mile (Mission Trails), North Fortuna Peak Loop: On Fri, 17 Jan 2020 (third Friday), we gather at 8:30 AM at the Catalina entrance. (Go east on Clairemont Mesa Blvd: make a left turn on Villa Vallarta. Go two blocks, and make a right turn on to Collegio Drive - up the hill to a "T". Turn left on to Alejo Street - which curves around to the right. At the third left, turn left on to Belardo Drive. Go one block, & turn right on to Camino Playa Catalina. The road eventually curves around to the left, a canyon appears off to the right. with no houses on that side. Keep climbing; park on the right near where the road ends.) Wearing long pants is desirable. Bringing a hiking stick (or two) is recommended.




